The issue of Petition filed in the Supreme Court on Child Marriage Act was discussed. It was decided to conduct Consultation in the Commission for arriving at a consensus in the matter.

It was further decided that Members may conduct programmes and recommend proposals not included in the Agenda Item 1, for conducting consultation on selected topics. In this regard, Smt. Nirmala Samant Prabhavalkar, Member, NCW suggested National level Consultation in Mumbai and Chennai on "Portrayal of Women in Media – and Role of CBFC and Minister (I&B)" and this proposal was approved by the Commission.

The Commission may also conduct programmes in collaboration with College, Universities, State Women Commissions etc.
